



### VMS CONCEPT

- Transceiver ("Blue Box")
- Position reports
- Fisheries Monitoring Center (FMC)








### BENEFITS

- better monitoring
- better deployment of control and surveillance resources
- greater transparency





### VMS and the COASTAL MEMBER STATE

Automatic transmission of position reports to the FMC of the coastal Member State



### VMS and THIRD COUNTRY VESSELS

VMS applies to third country vessels when operating in EU waters since 1 January 2000




### NORTH EAST ATLANTIC FISHERIES COMMISSION (N E A F C)





### COMMON FISHERIES POLICY REFORM

#### **Includes an extension of VMS:**

- as from 2004, to fishing vessels exceeding
   18 metres in length,
- as from 2005, to fishing vessels exceeding
   15 metres in length

### **EU ENLARGEMENT**

Accession Treaty with 10 applicant countries.

On joining the EU in May 2004, the new Member States are expected to accept the "acquis".

### STRICTER RULES

- single regulation
- less exemptions
- detailed rules for third country vessels in Community waters
- speed and course mandatory in position reports (as from 2006)
- geographical position expressed in decimal degrees





# STRICTER RULES (Ctd.)



- manual reporting every 4 hours in case of technical failure
- prevention of tampering
- responsibilities better specified



#### **NEW APPLICATIONS**

- Progressive introduction of electronic logbooks & reporting of information on fishing activities,
- Combination with remote sensing data,
- ...
